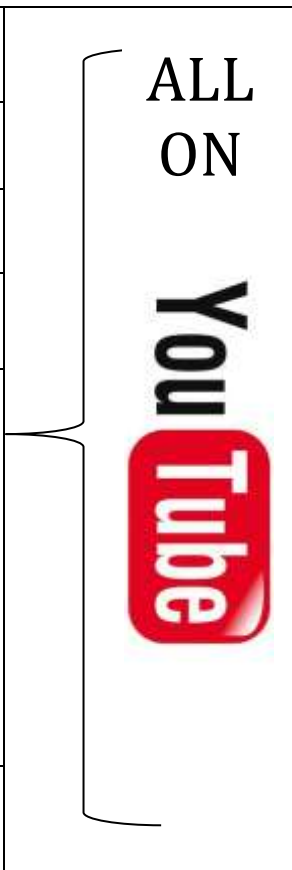

## HOLY WEEK – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- **Do keep your eye on the front page of the website. It is from here that you will find latest updates, download sheets for our masses, YouTube links for mass and of course the parish website.**
- **Please try to enter into the Holy Week Services as and when they are streamed as you might do were you in church.**
- **You might like to set up an area or indeed room in your house as your chapel for the week. Have a crucifix to venerate on Good Friday, candles, and strong WiFi!**
- **So sorry but confession is not being allowed at the moment. This is as much a problem for priests as yourselves. The Good Friday stations at 10 am (see below) will include a short liturgy of penitence. The real spiritual challenge is to be able to tell yourself that God is merciful and actually understands, especially if you are a regular penitent**
- **As mentioned earlier on this week, if anybody would be willing to be part of a team offering friendly chats over the phone, to the vulnerable but also parishioners in general, please pass your details to Fr Gary**
- **Also as mentioned earlier on this week, the parish has been set up with a subscription to Word on Fire Engage. Simply this is a series of online mini-courses which parishioners can journey through, which also provides a facility for a parish exclusive forum to share our thoughts. Please let Fr Gary know if interested, we intend to launch this in the middle of Holy Week.**
- **Everything possible will be done to celebrate Holy Week in the best way possible. Some of you will be contacted to record a video of yourself doing a reading. Please oblige if you can, and try to keep file sizes small.**
- **I am afraid the presbytery landline remains inoperative. The line was damaged by council employees mowing the grass outside the presbytery. Its repair is a two man job and virginmedia who are not known for their customer service cannot help at the moment due to COVID 19 etc.**
- **On Good Friday morning a simple stations of the cross will be livestreamed at 10 am. Please join us.**
